A limited number of Student Assistant positions will be available for individuals interested in working at the 2016 AAAR Annual Meeting. Once we have received enough applications to fulfill the needs of the conference, the application process will be closed. Assistants perform a variety of important tasks that ensure the smooth functioning of workshops, platforms and poster sessions, as well as numerous activities. You will be required to monitor four (4) sessions at the conference. In return for this service, students may attend two (2) tutorials free of charge.

STUDENT ASSISTANT PARTICIPATION POLICY

PLEASE DO NOT COMPLETE THIS FORM IF YOU CAN NOT MEET THE CRITERIA BELOW.

- 1. Students **MUST** attend a student assistant orientation on Sunday, October 16, 2016 at 7:30pm (local time) at the Oregon Convention Center in Portland. You must schedule a flight to arrive Sunday afternoon and have a hotel reservation for Sunday night. If you are not present at the meeting, you will not be able to attend tutorials on Monday, October 17 and you will not be able to participate as an assistant during the week.
- 2. Students **MUST** be prompt and agree to be present for the entire time during the four (4) sessions to which they are assigned.
- 3. Students **MUST** stay for the entire conference and be available to work the final session on Friday afternoon (typically ends prior to 2:00 p.m.)

If you apply to be a student assistant and consequently fail to perform your duties, your adviser will be notified. Further, if you attend tutorials on Monday and fail to fulfill your commitment throughout the week, you will be invoiced for the cost of two (2) tutorials at the student on-site rate. There will be a daily check in desk in Portland for all student assistants.
